- the UNCRC (United Nations Convention on the Rights of Child)
- understanding children rights
- young people participation and youth voice

SCHOOL COUNCIL TRAINING

- FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

This training focuses on:

- understanding the role of school council representative
- understanding the role of a school council
- understand the role of a school council in wider decision making

ASSOCIATED PUPIL GOVERNORS*

- GOVERNOR INDUCTION TRAINING:

This training focuses on:

- the different types of governors and the role of the Chair and Clerk
- key roles and responsibilities of governing bodies
- what makes an effective governing body and the governor's role in school improvement

UNDERSTANDING THE LEVELS OF DEMOCRACY**

This training focuses on:

- understanding the role and power of a County Council, Welsh Assembly and UK Parliament
- understanding who represents them at each level.
- understanding what it means to vote and myth busting.

- provide examples of participation activities that can be used with young people

SCOUTS & GUIDES: RIGHTS CHALLENGE

The badge enables Scouts and Guides to learn more about Children's Rights and about the Children's Commissioner.

This badge has been developed to inform children and young people about the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC), and the role of the Children's Commissioner for Wales.

The badge has been designed so that young people can lead their own learning.

The Participation Team will deliver the programme.
